

Make your own Bishop!

You will need:

1 person outline, copied or stuck on to card
1 cope and mitre sheet
Scissors and coloured pencils
Glue

How to make your Bishop

Draw a face and hair on the person outline and then carefully cut the person out.

Follow the instructions to cut out the cope and mitre.

Think about what sort of picture you want on the cope. This is called a symbol and there are some ideas at the bottom of this sheet. Draw the symbol on the cope and colour it all in. Colour in the mitre.

The mitre has to be stuck together round the sides so that it fits on the Bishop's head.

Fold the cope along the lines and put it over your Bishop's shoulders (the symbol should be on the Bishop's back).

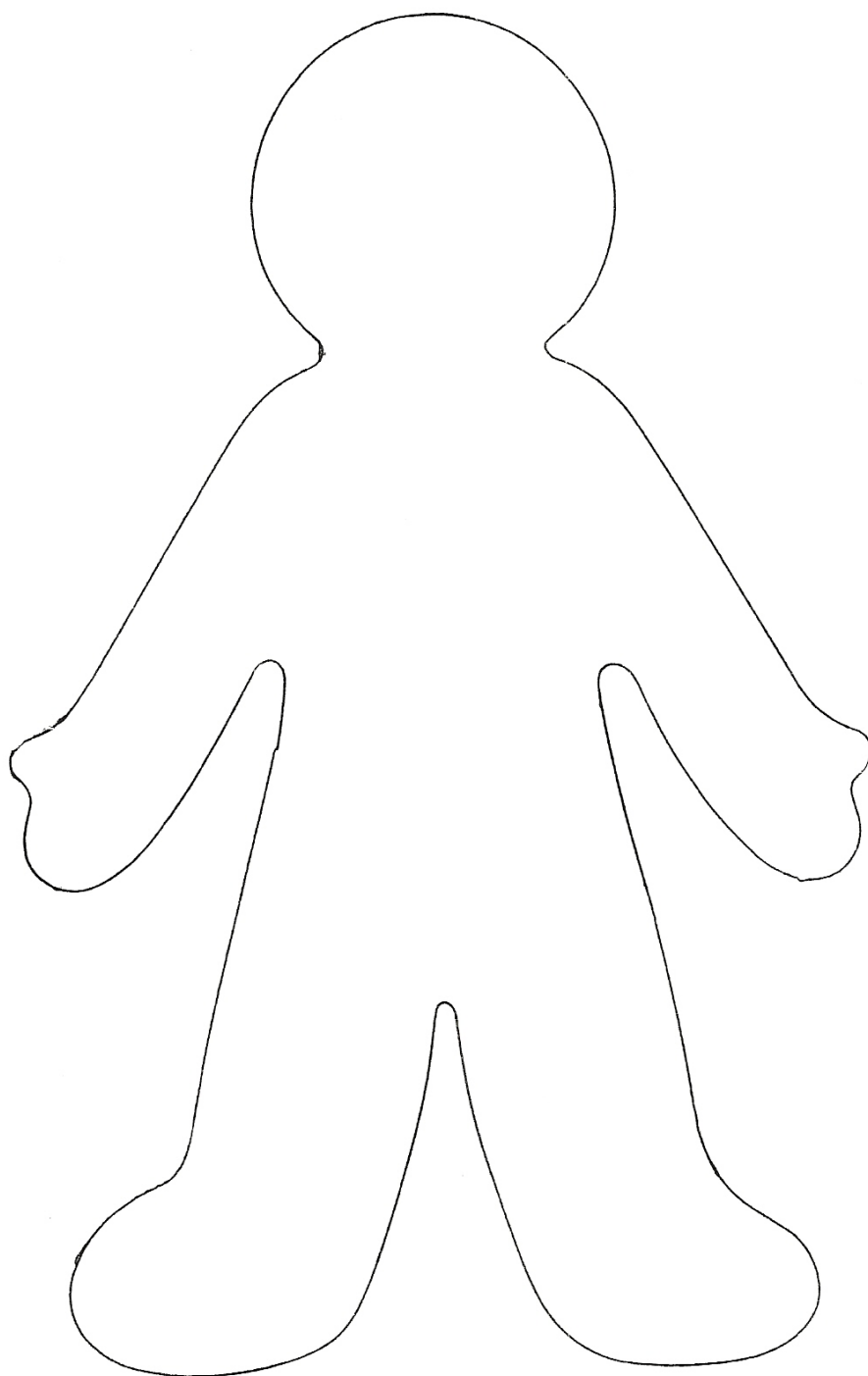
Put the mitre on the Bishop's head.

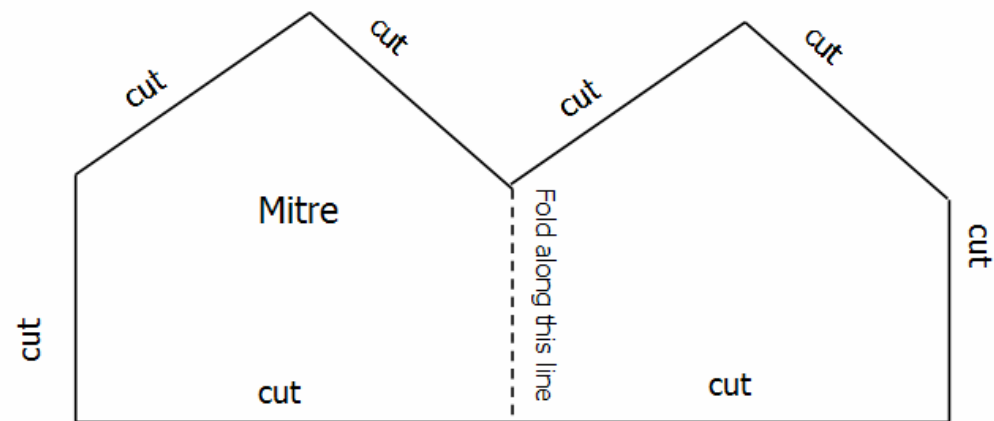
