



Fourth Sunday of Easter

Find this story in your bibles in John 10. 1 - 10

Start with a discussion:

What does it mean to follow the teachings of Jesus? Will they make you a kind and caring person to other people?

The story

Do you know what a shepherd is? They take care of sheep and guide them to food, water and make sure they have somewhere safe and comfortable to rest.

In this bible story today Jesus is telling us that we are His flock, that we are His sheep and He is our shepherd. Jesus is guiding us to do the best thing for ourselves and others. He teaches us stories in the Bible so that we can learn how to be a good Christian and help others.

Today in our activity, we're going to make our family flock which you can display in your house, to remind you that if we follow Jesus He will guide us.



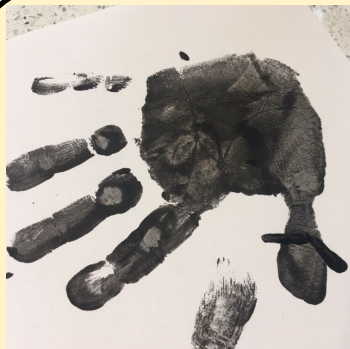
Activity:

You will need:

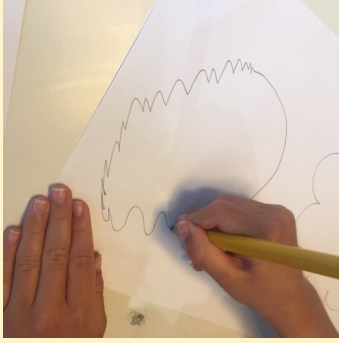
- White paper/card
- Black paper/card (optional)
- Scissors
- A drawing pencil
- Black paint
- Felt tip pen
- Cotton wool or light coloured wool (optional)



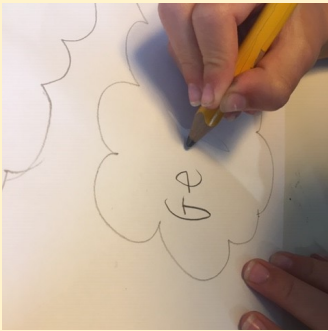
Get everyone in your family to lightly paint one hand with paint and print it on to a sheet of plain or light coloured paper.



While you have the paint brush, carefully add two ears onto your hand print. This should be roughly near where your knuckle is on your thumb. Set aside your paper to dry and wash your hand!



Draw out the outline of your sheep's fleece and then carefully cut out Cut out the body/fleece of your sheep.



Add your names on to each sheep's fleece.



Stick the body, head and head together. Add eyes.



Your family flock is ready to be displayed!
