## Start with a discussion:

- What is Lent?
- How long does Lent last?
- What special day signifies the end of Lent?

## The story

This week's Gospel reading begins with us being reminded about another story in the Bible. The story was about Moses creating a bronze serpent. Can you try and find this story?

Today's reading is about God wanting us to think about how we can be good Christians. Are we kind to others? Do we treat others as we would like to be treated ourselves? Do we follow the teachings of Jesus?

Once you find the story of Moses, try making this week's craft activity. The serpent is to remind you how in the story with Moses, all the people who believed in God we're saved from the serpents. It was their faith that saved them.

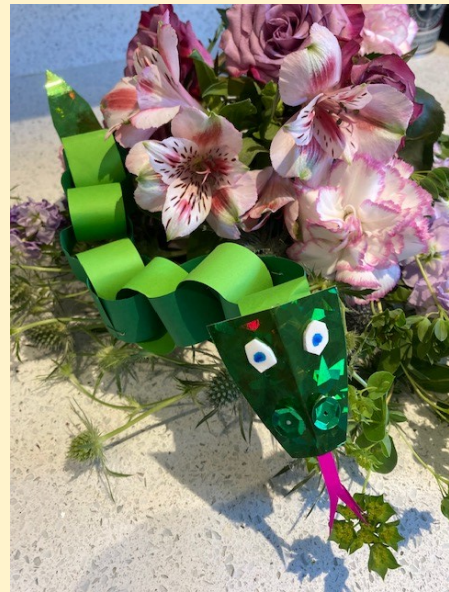


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## Activity: Paper chain serpent

### You will need:

- Paper
- Glue, tape or stapler
- Pens/pencils
- Scissors



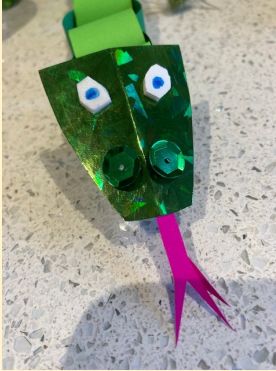
Cut sections of paper into strips 2cm x 11cm.



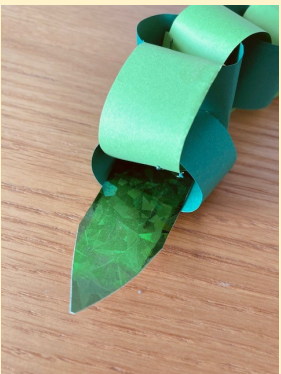
Link together into a paper chain. Make this as long or as short as you like



Cut out a triangle for the head.



Add eyes and a nose. You can even add a tongue!  
Attach to one end of the paper chain.



Next add a long thin triangle for the tail and attach at  
the remaining empty end of the paper chain.
