



Palm Sunday

Find this story in your Bible: Mark 15. 1 - end

Sunday 28th March 2021

Start with a discussion:

- Have you seen any pictures or footage of the Queen on visits? Are there people in the crowd? What are they waving?
- What happened to Jesus on Palm Sunday?

The story

Today's Gospel reading is telling us what is going to happen in the Bible between today, Palm Sunday, through the week ahead known as Holy Week.

As you listen to the reading today do you think you can create a drawing to represent each section of it? Use the following as a guide:

- Jesus before Pilate
- Pilate hands over Jesus to be crucified
- Soldiers mock Jesus
- The crucifixion
- The death of Jesus
- The burial of Jesus.



Activity: Palms from palms

You will need:

- Green card or paper
- Scissors
- Glue



Draw around your hands making sure you draw around each finger. Draw all the way down past your wrist too.

You will need at least 9 to 12 hands for 1 palm leaf. You can do this as a family so all your hand shapes go into making 1 palm leaf .



Cut out your hand shapes.



Make the stem by rolling a piece of A4 paper into a tube and fixing the loose edge with glue.



Starting with the top, glue one hand on. Repeat and overlap each hand until you have covered the tube on one side. Make sure you leave a part of the paper tube clear so that this can be your handle.



Leave and let the glue dry and then you can either wave them or display them!
