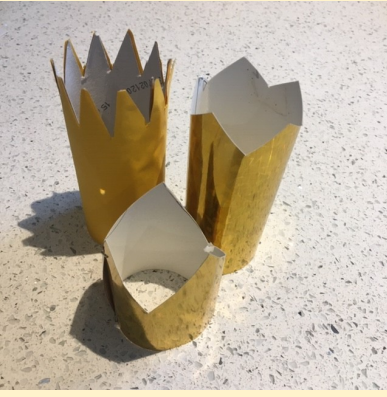
Activity: Epiphany

You will need:

- Toilet rolls x3
- Gold or yellow paint or paper
- Tissue paper (optional)
- Decorations (optional)



Cut the top of each of the toilet roll tube to make it look like a crown.



Paint each of the crowns gold or yellow.
Alternatively cover in glittered papers or yellow paper.
Leave to dry.



Add tissue paper on as many crowns as you like by pushing in from the base of the crown.
