Start with a discussion:

What is a 'second chance'?

What does the word 'forgiveness' mean?

The story

In this week's reading we hear that God is a God of love, who cares for us enough to offer second chances, when we make the wrong choices. God is a God who forgives.

We will all make mistakes throughout our lives, but it's understanding when we make them and how we can learn from them.

This week's activity is about 'turning over a new leaf'. This is a phrase that is used when people stop behaving in one way and improve things they do, to be better people. We have also just moved from one season into another. We are now in autumn, where the trees drop their leaves and go into a time of renewal too.

Activity: Leaf Wreath

You will need:

- **To collect leaves!**
- **Cardboard**
- **String/Ribbon**
- **Glue**
- **Scissors**



Use a large circular plate, pan lid or mixing bowl to create your outer circle of the wreath.



Find a smaller circular plate or bowl to make the inner circle of your wreath. Cut out (you may need to ask an adult to help you).



Tie your string or ribbon onto the cardboard.



Lay out your leaves until you have covered all of the cardboard.



Glue them all down and then leave to dry.
