The story

This week Jesus tells us the Parable of the Wedding Banquet.

Jesus is explaining to us that God is like the King in the story. But instead of inviting us to a wedding, God is inviting us to be part of His family. All God expects of us is to believe in Him. We can also spread the word and invite others to join us as part of His family too.

In this week's activity, you can make a crown to remind you of the Parable of the Wedding Feast. Remember that God invited you to be part of His family and all He wants in return is for you to believe in Him.





Activity: The King's Wedding Banquet Crown

You will need:


- Card
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Decorations





Find something circular that has a diameter of approximately 18cm. Draw around it on your card.



Draw another circle that is 2cm bigger, on the outside of the first circle.



Using a ruler, split the centre circle into 8, so it looks like a pizza! To do this draw a line through the middle of the centre circle. Add another line through to cut the circle into quarters or 4. Repeat until you have 8 sections.



Cut out the circle. Then cut the lines down to the outer circle. Fold the triangles up, this then forms the crown.



You can fold the triangles back down to decorate. Make your crown look magnificent by drawing or sticking decorations on to it!



Let it dry and then you can wear it. It will remind you that you are part of God's family.
